

Quokka Scavenger Hunt – Terms and Conditions

1. Instructions on how to participate and other details contained within promotional advertisements for this activity form part of the conditions of participation.
2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to these Terms and Conditions.
3. The Terms and Conditions of this competition are governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
4. The competition is being run by Rottnest Island Authority, PO Box 693, Fremantle WA 6959 (“Rottnest Island Authority”).
5. The “Quokka Scavenger Hunt” (“the competition”) commences at 10am Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) on Sunday 18 September 2022.
6. The closing time for completing the competition is 4pm AWST on Sunday, 18th September 2022. Staff employed by the Rottnest Island Authority, Rottnest Island businesses, their immediate family members and members of the Rottnest Voluntary Guide Association are not eligible to enter the competition.
7. To enter the competition, the entrant must:
 - a. Visit the “Quokka Base” next to the shopping area in Thomson Bay on Rottnest Island to collect a Quokka Scavenger Hunt Card and begin the Treasure Hunt.
 - b. Follow the instructions to each location to find the answers to each question; and
 - c. Correctly enter the answer to each question on the card; and
 - d. Return to the “Quokka Base” once all answers have been entered.
8. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all incidental costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing and staying at Rottnest Island.
9. Entrants may only enter the competition once by completing all the questions correctly.
10. Children who complete the Scavenger Hunt will receive a participation prize from the spinning wheel at the “Quokka Base”. By spinning the wheel, the type of prize will be determined.
11. Prizes are limited and subject to availability and include 100 tattoos, 50 Quokka T Shirts, 10 ice-creams, 250 playing cards, 50 mini quokka chocolates, 240 stickers 50 crayons, 30 calendars and 20 pens.
12. The prize is not redeemable for cash or an alternative prize.
